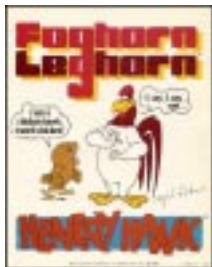

451. Mel Blanc.

Color 8.5 x 11 paperstock promotional photo of Foghorn Leghorn and Henery Hawk, signed in black ink by Blanc. In fine condition, with some scattered light creasing and punch holes to left edge. Accompanied by a letter from the gentleman who obtained the signature in person. (MB \$45)



452. Al Capp. FDC, 6.5 x 3.75, with a cachet honoring Francis Scott Key, signed boldly on the front in fountain pen. In fine condition. (MB \$40)

453. Cartoonists. A collection of 16 original signed ink sketches on 4 x 6 cards by Lindstrom, Cooke, Szorady, Blake, Casson, Warner (in pencil), Graue, Chon Day, Myers, Eastman, Dick Rogers, Will Eisner, Parisi (3 x 5), Turner (3 x 5), Carpenter (hand colored), and Ferdinand (hand colored). 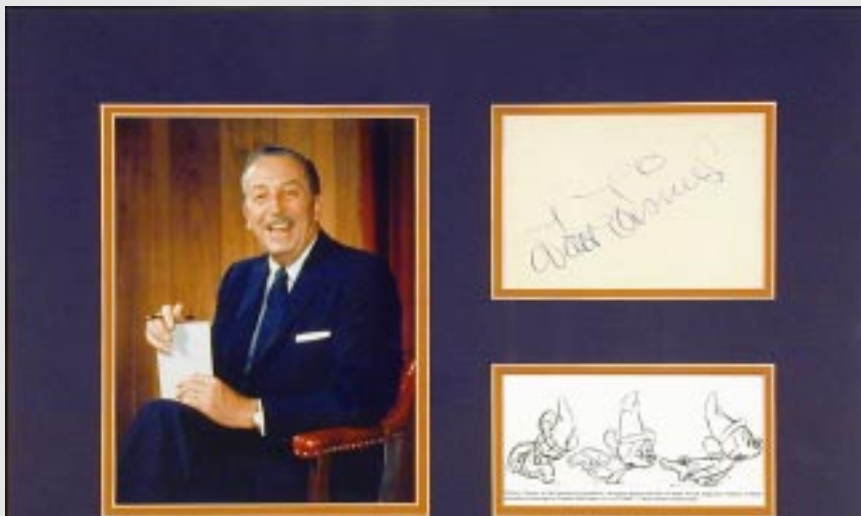
455. [Disney: Snow White]. Original unsigned sheet music for *Whistle While You Work* from *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs*, 9 x 12, and dated 1937. Front cover depicts Snow White and all seven dwarfs. In fine condition, with light cover wear, some toning to inside pages and an unknown ownership signature, dated 1938, on the front cover.(MB \$100)



456. [Disney: Three Little Pigs]. Original unsigned sheet music for *Who's Afraid of the Big Bad Wolf*, 9 x 12 and dated 1933. Front cover shows the pigs cavorting while being watched by the wolf. In fine condition, with some cover separation along spine and some light page toning.(MB \$100)

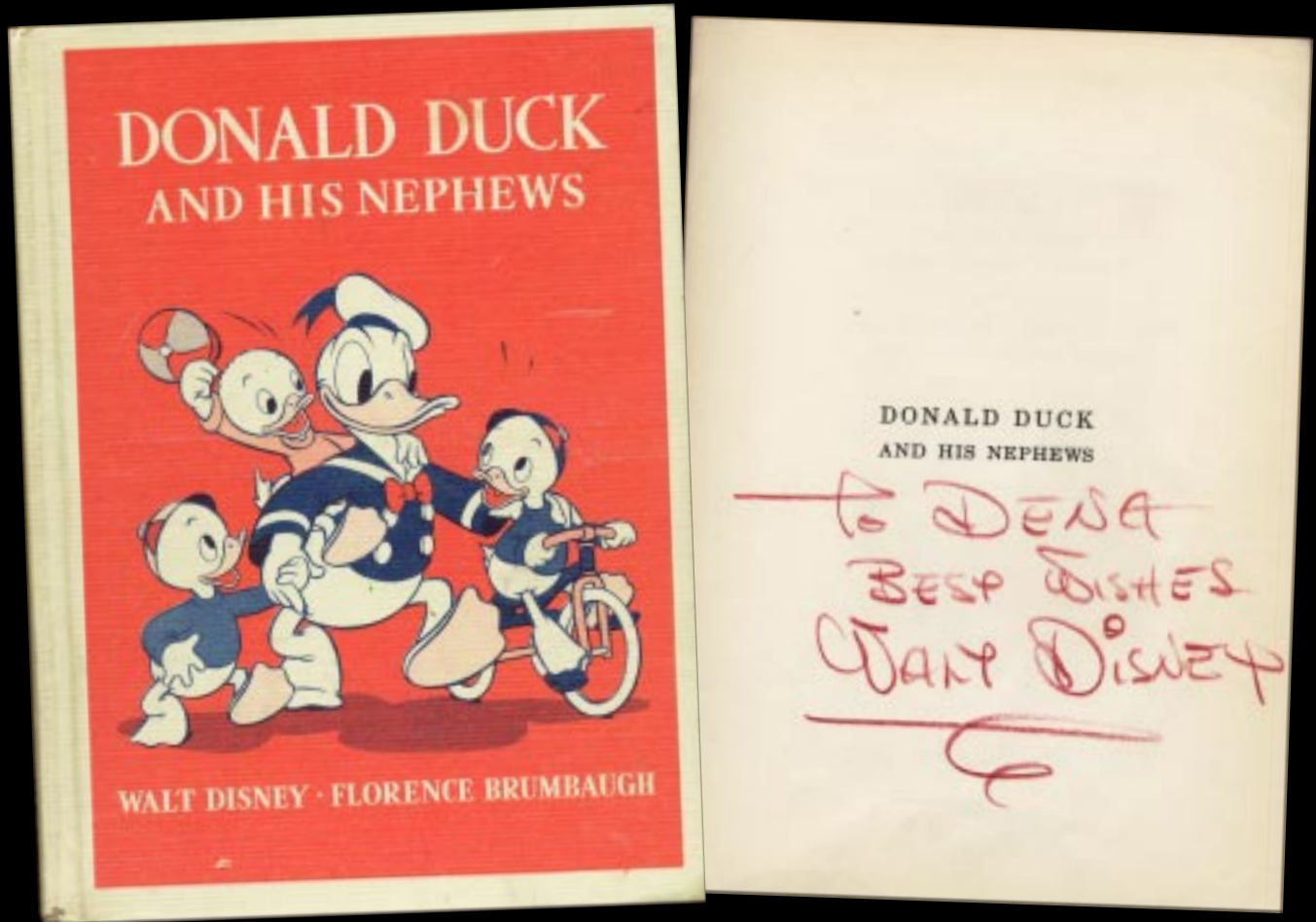
457. [Walt Disney]. The 1961 roster of the Rancheros Visitadores Riding Club. Spiral bound roster measures 4.5 x 6.5 and is 164 pages long. Disney joined this club in 1938 and was a member until he died, and is pictured inside. Other members included Noah Berry, Jr., Edgar Bergen, Montie Montana and Jim Rogers. This club is considered the most elite trail riding club in the world. Ronald Reagan became a member in the mid '60's. In fine condition, with a bit of light handling wear.(MB \$50)

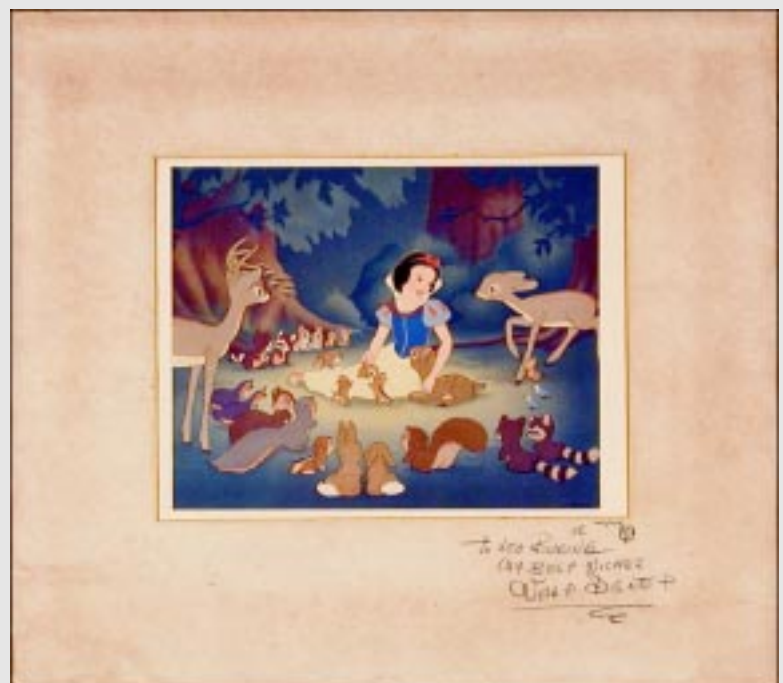

In fine condition, with an old bookplate affixed to inside front cover, some light page toning and cover wear. .(MB \$2000)

460. Walt Disney. Color vintage 15 x 12 photo of Snow White with her woodland friends, matted to an overall size of 18 x 16, signed and inscribed on the matte in pencil "To Leo Buring, My best wishes, Walt Disney," with an early "WD," trademark stamp above it. Affixed to the reverse of photo is the original promotional write-up from the Courvoisier Galleries, stating that the photo is a reproduction of one of the famous Disney originals. In fine condition, with some scattered light soiling and toning to matte. Nice example of an early Disney signature.(MB \$2000)





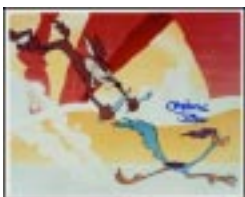
461. Friz Freleng. Original signed pencil sketch of Bugs Bunny on a white 7 x 10.5 card. In fine condition. (MB \$200)
