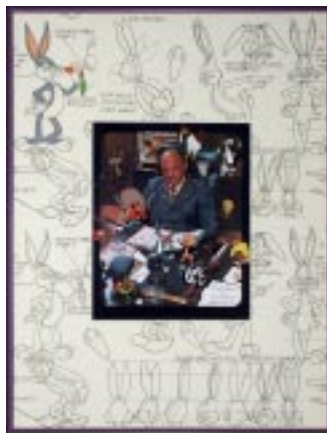

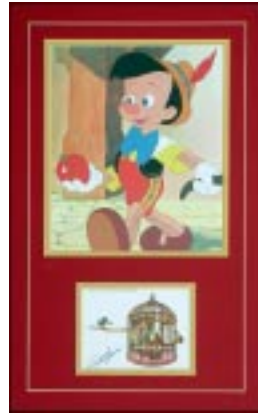

Attractive color 7.5 x 10 dye-transfer print of Mickey Mouse standing in either an office or a library, with the shelves covered in books and awards, in honor of his twenty-fifth anniversary, done by Disney artist John Hench in 1953, signed in black artists pencil by Disney on the cream colored 13.5 x 17 mat, "All best wishes, Walt Disney." Back of the item has the original backing which bears the top portion of the original Disney label. 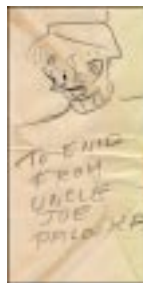

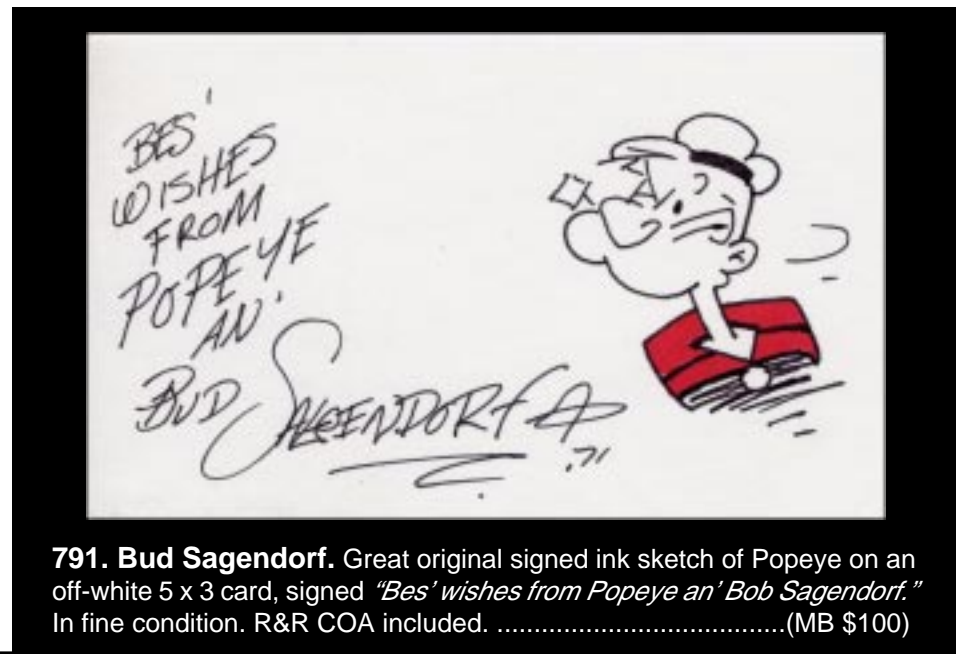

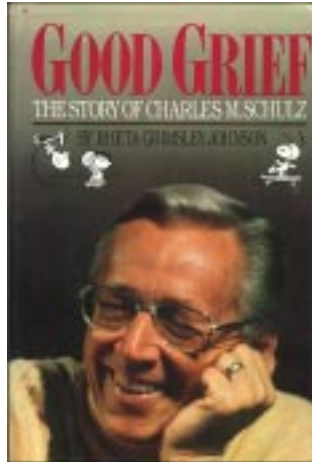

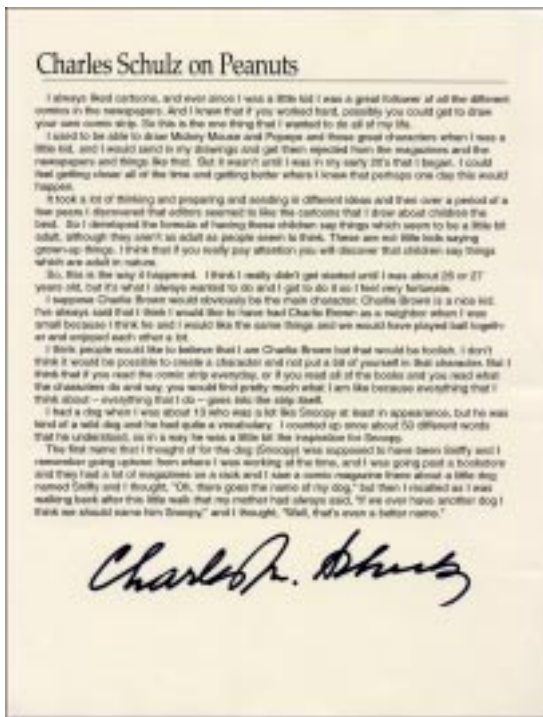

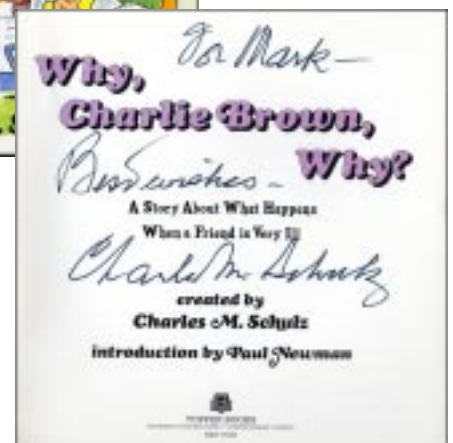
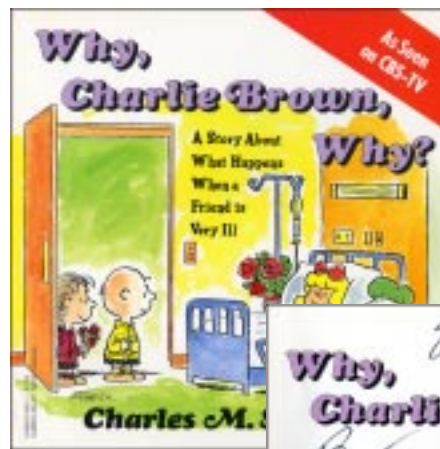

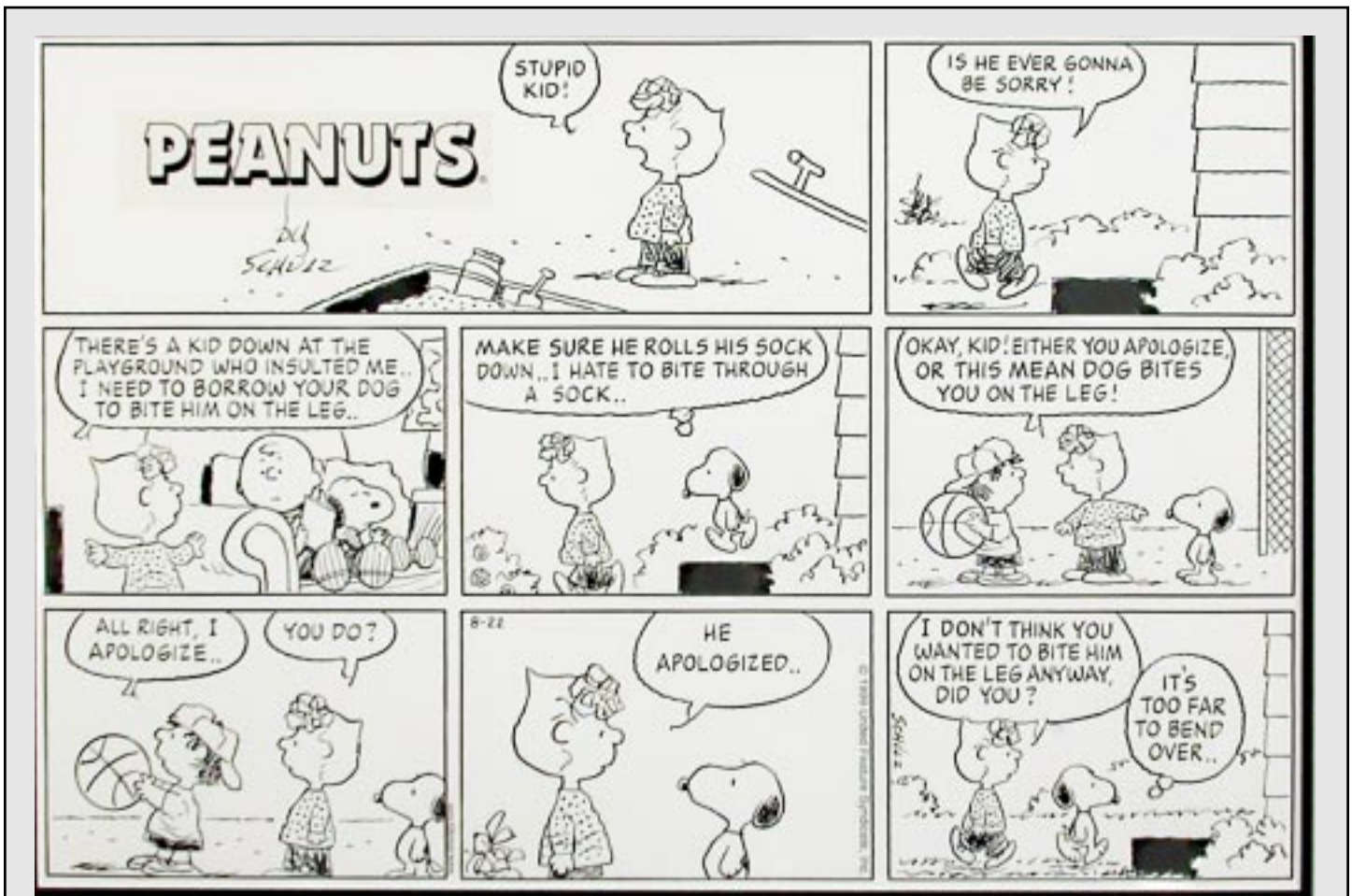

This strip was originally sold by Schulz to raise money for a comic art museum in San Francisco. Nicely double matted and framed to a size of 29.75 x 22.5. 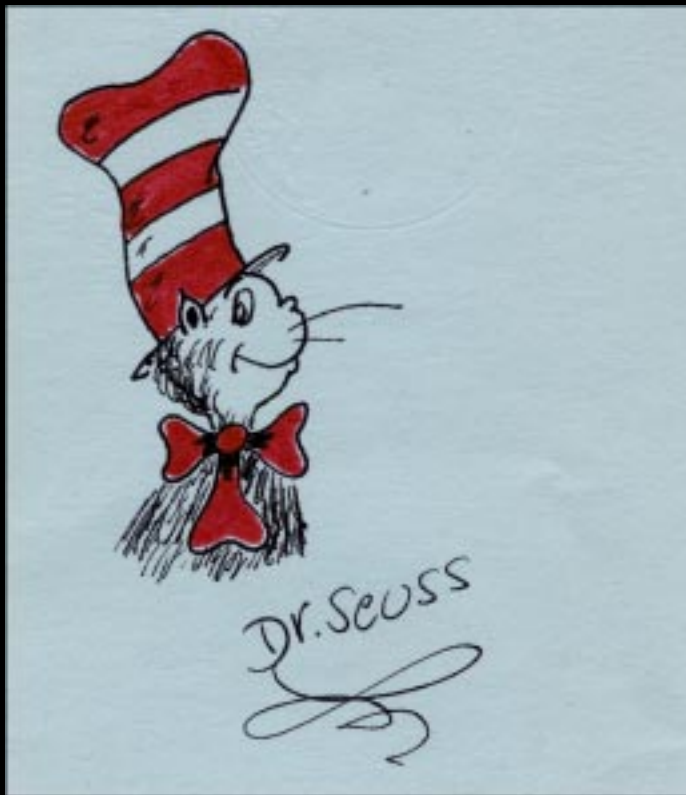
